6. Report of the Clerk: Dickie Nook Bus Shelter:

- 1) A recent vehicle collision has forced Pendle Borough Council to demolish the shelter. After discussion with Pendle it became clear that it would not be replaced. After consultation with the Chairman the Clerk contacted Pendle and obtained a quote of £880 for the installation of a new concrete base and erection of the shelter in the parish's possession. A grant application for the £880 has been submitted to the BWPAC and will be considered on Thursday night.
- 2) **John David:** Former leader of Pendle Borough Council and Chairman of the BWPAC has passed away. Cllr Nike said that she would attend his funeral on behalf of the Parish Council
- 3) **Christmas Decorations:** The trees have been ordered for collection following Remembrance Sunday.
- 4) War Memorial Roll of Honour: Further research has highlighted at least one serviceman who has been omitted from the Roll of Honour from the two world wars and although it is probably

too late to add the name before the 11th November can funding be found to enable the additions before next year's Remembrance Service. It was always the intention to research servicemen who were killed in other conflicts or while in the service of the armed forces, a request has been made by a resident to commemorate Private Sutcliffe who was killed in Northern Ireland 25 years ago.
