Printer Lease:

The three year lease on the council's printer come to an end shortly with the Council needing to identify another lease. The clerk has contacted Copifax our current suppliers who in the intervening period have become part of the Sharp's and spoke to their sales manager. Mr Peers who sent the council the following quotation:

Cost based over a 3 year lease rental £126.00 per quarter Plus 2 year extension at the end of the lease at Nil Rental Cost

Service includes all parts, labour, call outs, firmware upgrades and ALL TONER and is charged on a cost per copy basis at 0.44p mono and 3.95p colour

Colour Service 850 pages x 3.95p £33.58

These averages were taken before you re started the Newsletter, so in reality your future savings will be much greater.

These prices will reduce the councils existing costs and the inclusion of colour toner will further reduce overall costs, the two year rent/lease free period at the end of the three year lease period was not available on the current printer and is the result of negotiating a better deal with the supplier as due to low volume printing the machines are still serviceable.

The discussion with Mr Peers also includes retention of the existing machine until the correct configuration of printer becomes available.
